

MMYC club scoring procedures for 2010

1. 2010 racing season will use the same scoring procedure as we did in 2009.
2. The entire season will be scored as one regatta with a total of 63 races and 14 throw outs using the low point system. Monthly standings will be posted on the web site.
3. The Race Director points will be awarded as follows:

The RD receives a score of 1 point for every race in each class that he/she normally races for a total of 7 points for each class.

The first place slot remains empty if the RD is not a class racer.

If there are two RD's from a class both get a first place finish.

4. The winner of each race receives a score of 2 points and each subsequent finisher earns a score of one point higher than his/her immediate predecessor.
5. No shows will be scored as the number of boats in the entire regatta plus 1 for every race missed. The no show score will change as the number of boats participating changes.
6. All other scoring procedures remain unchanged.
7. These changes were made to allow racers to keep their 49 best races. Under the previous system, there were many scenarios where a person had to throw out a day that included low scoring races because of an equipment failure or some other problem that caused him/her not to finish for the day.
8. Skippers joining MMYC after June 30 will be scored and posted but because of the number of races missed during the beginning of the season they will not be eligible for year end awards.

Rest assured that a rousing and thorough discussion occurred before these changes were made. It is our hope that the new system will provide accurate and fair scoring for all.
