

MMYC RACE DIRECTORS (RD) RESPONSIBILITIES/DUTIES

1. Secure the count-down player, boat house keys and applicable scorers documents.
2. Arrive at the Lake prior to 8:30 to set the marks.
3. Set the marks using the dingy; wear pfd while underway. Lake "Kitt" is reportedly 4'-5' deep. Wilde Lake is reportedly 7'-8' deep. Longer anchor rode maybe necessary during heavier winds.
4. Race schedule:
Victoria 9:30 – 11:30
EC-12 12:00- 2:00
ODOM 2:30- 4:30
5. Races shall not begin before these posted times.
6. RDs shall hold a brief skippers' meeting prior to the start of the race to discuss the course to be sailed; whether hitting some marks results in a penalty, securing waivers for non MMYC members, and other issues.
7. Complete at least 7 races. Try to vary the sailing experiences for the skippers.
8. RDs call the starts and finishing positions.
9. A race is cancelled at a lightening strike or thunder clap. The next race is started 30 minutes after the last thunder clap or lightening strike.
10. Record the sail number and finishing order for each race. Return all information to scorer.
11. Wrap-up: secure all marks, dingy, support equipment. Note any discrepancies and report them to the MMYC equipment manager. This will benefit the next RD and keep MMYC's equipment operational.
12. Connect battery to battery charger and then plug in charger.
